If any KS2 children would like to keep Mr Day company & run a few laps with him, they are more than welcome to. Any laps run will be added the final total ran during the day. Parents are welcome to either drop off/ pick up their child by Class Bray or stay and watch, although we kindly ask you remain socially distanced from others and avoid standing around in groups etc. Younger children will not be allowed to play on the field or playground whilst waiting.

Although Mr Day will be running around the field, the children will be running unsupervised. There will be no staff to support the children running. There will be a toilet available in Class Bray. KS1 children will get the opportunity to run with Mr Day earlier in the school day.
