We are very excited for the WOW day next Tuesday. The children are looking forward to all the activities planned.



#### Children's wellbeing


We are expecting children to get colds and potentially Flu now that we are back in school. These are to be expected and we are aware that in the current climate these illnesses may cause additional anxiety.



The usual rules apply in terms of sickness and diarrhoea with children having to remain at home for 48 hours clear of any D&V.

We know this week has been very stressful for several families whose children have been poorly, especially if you are trying to get tested. Please make the decision as to whether you want to keep your child at home. **We are not doctors** so cannot make that decision for you. If a child arrives at school with a bit of a cold and/or cough, we will keep a close eye on them, especially as we need to keep the children, staff and the rest of our community safe too. It may be the case that we need to send the young person home, in which case we will contact you.

We are of course following very strict hygiene practises within school, but as predicted when many children and adults are brought together after months being apart then some illness will happen. This is happening nationally across all schools.

## Safely arriving and leaving school

We have been informed by some very concerned and anxious parents that some parents congregate on or around the school site before and after school. It is essential that all children arrive and leave at their designated start or finish time. All adults must always maintain social distancing to reduce the chance of the transmitting the virus. Please leave a clear and wide pathway for children to safely walk through to get to their class. Please do not block any gate areas.

Please can we remind you, that the children in Class Lyn and Bray start school at 9.00am and Taw and Torridge at 8.50am. Please can parents of children in Class Bray wait until children in class Taw and Torridge have entered school before they take their children to Class Bray.

Please can we ensure that all reception and Y1 parents in Class Bray are NOT walking though the staff car park before or after school unless they have requested permission to do due to having a pushchair or medical needs. Walking through the car park is big health and safety risk for us as the school taxi, minibus and staff's cars may be moving around the car park at any of the drop off times.

Therefore, after taking H&S advice, if you have asked for permission to walk through the car park, we have decided to close the staff car park gate at 8.55am to 9.10am and 2.55pm to 3.05pm so the few families that have asked can walk through the car park safely. As these timings have to be so very tight due to vehicles requiring access, please do NOT use the staff car park as a walk through if you have not asked for permission. We need to be able to do this as quickly as possible so the gate can be opened quickly. Please do not allow other children to join up with other families to walk through the car park.
