Everyone is welcome to attend our Harvest Festival the service will be held in St Peter's Church on Wednesday 20th October at 11:00am. This year, we will be collecting for the Freedom Centre. The Centre has been closed throughout lockdown but the charity continued to operate with a smaller team of staff, working closely with North Devon Council to engage with those who are homeless. They have supported the Food Bank with fresh and ambient food donations, as well as giving out food parcels and Food Bank vouchers to those in need. The Centre is now planning to re-open and would be grateful of any donations of: -

Tins: chopped tomatoes, baked beans, meat and fish
Tinned meals: beef casserole, chicken curry, pot noodles and pasta pots
(with ring pulls if possible as some people may not have access to a tin opener)
Dried herbs and spices, pepper
Fruit
Cous cous (not rice or pasta)
Sugar, custard and rice pudding
Coffee, cocoa, instant hot chocolate drink, fruit squash (not tea)
Baking ingredients: dried fruit, baking powder, vanilla essence, chocolate
Sauces: brown sauce, tomato sauce and mayonnaise
Non-bio washing powder, washing up liquid, kitchen rolls
Toilet rolls, shower gel, shampoo and hand wash (not bars of soap)
Cereal bars, granola bars and chocolate biscuit bars
