Pre-School

In the Bunnies area we have been exploring the topic Remembrance. We have had a range of activities out throughout the week, in our tuff tray we have had red rice, black Pom-poms and we also added spoons to scoop and pour the rice which encourages the children to practice their whole hand grasp. We used apples and red paint to make a poppy picture and the children have also enjoyed singing a range of songs at group time such as, incy wincy spider, head shoulders knees and toes and row, row, row your boat.

In Deers, we have been thinking about Night time. The children were very excited to talk about the fireworks they had seen at the weekend, so we made some colourful firework pictures in the art area. We have talked about the difference between day and night, and about the animals that come out whilst we are asleep and we had a go at making some animal dens in the woodlands! We have looked at the moon and stars, made delicious Moon Rock Cakes, and the children have particularly enjoyed exploring the lightbox by using their fingers and paintbrushes to make shapes in the salt and glitter. On Thursday we talked a little bit about Remembrance Day and watched a video called Bunnies at 11am. We made some beautiful poppy pictures, took part in an obstacle course, and practiced marching with the musical instruments.
