We are thrilled to be able to tell you that both Holywell and Bratton have joined up with Edukids a wonderful charity based in Bideford.

Edukid work with children living in extreme poverty in Uganda. They support students through their education, from primary school all the way up to university and vocational training. Edukid believes that all children have the right to attend school, and that it is a long-term solution to enabling communities to break out of the poverty cycle. Before the Harvest Festival Service Edukids will be introducing themselves to the children in an assembly at school and then the representative will be joining us at the church service.
