Remembrance Day

We have received a most wonderful letter today from a parishioner congratulating us and the children on how well they behaved whilst standing at the church memorial for 2 minutes silence.

Please note the following message about bad weather:

Severe weather conditions and the closure of School

I thought I would take the opportunity to update you on the procedures for the closure of the school in bad weather.

- 1. We will send out a text message to all parents asap.
- 2. Listen to Heart Radio
- 3. news.devon@heart.co.uk
- 4. If you are unsure, telephone school on 01598710337. We will always have staff, if at all possible, to answer the telephone. We will always try, wherever possible, to remain open.

Alternatively it may be safer to open school later than normal. Individual families should assess the risk posed by their journey to school and make their own decision. Many families who live close to the school will have a different level of risk to those who have much more complex travel arrangements. Let's hope that we have a trouble free winter.

Parking We have been asked to inform parents not to park on the pavements outside of school. No child should be brought to school or collected via the staff car park. At the beginning and end of the school day this route is used by the school bus and taxi.
