Bratton Fleming Pre-School

We've had a wonderful time at pre-school this week continuing to learn about winter and birds we may see at winter time. We have been looking at pictures of magpies, robins and blue tits and then having painting them, we talked about the colours of the birds and had a go at colour mixing.

We have had great fun collecting sticks in the woodlands to create our own large nest in the tuff tray, we then added eggs and the following day we made birds using play-dough, googly eyes and feathers. We also made some delicious chocolate bird's nests using chocolate and shredded wheat.

In the Bunnies area we have been busy making some winter collages using different shades of blue tissue paper and glue. In our tuff tray we have had shaving foams, glitter and winter animals. We have also been practicing our jumping using the small trampoline. Outside we have been looking at the trees to see if we can find any birds, we listened very closely to see if we can hear them cheep.
