# A Message from Mrs Denham

Assemblies: A parent has asked about the schools assemblies and what we do in them, especially the assembly by Open the Book. We hold an assembly every day and according to the Education Act it has to be of "wholly or mainly of a broadly Christian character". Therefore, each day a different member of staff takes assembly and talks about our family values, morals, stories from the Bible, stories from other religions and so on. We try to have visitors in as often as possible too. On a Thursday our friends from the village come in and deliver Open The Book – they reinact stories from the Bible. Linda Watt our Chair of Governors has written more about what they do further in the newsletter. If any parents would like to discuss anything to do with assemblies, please make an appointment and I am very happy to discuss this further.
