## <u>School News</u> <u>A message from Mrs. Denham</u>

Welcome back to school. We hope you all managed to have a lovely summer holiday and were able to see family and friends. Now that the majority of COVID restrictions have been lifted we are trying to get school back to as normal as possible. We are so pleased that the Y5/6 residential to St George's House is going ahead in October, gymnastics will be resuming in a couple of weeks and other trips and visits are being organised.

Children will still be hand washing regularly and using hand sanitiser.

Please inform us before 9.15am if you need to keep your child off school if they are poorly.

As we have several children with a severe nut allergy in school, can we please ask that children DO NOT bring any food products containing nuts into school e.g. peanut butter sandwiches, flap jacks containing nuts, Nutella products, cereal bars containing nuts and so on.

At the start of the school day children in Class Bray and Lyn will need to be ready to enter school at 8.50am please. **No later please as registration** is at 8.50am

- Children in Class Bray to line up outside their classroom
- Children in Class Lyn will be met by a member of staff on the bottom playground
- Children in Classes Taw and Torridge will be met on the bottom playground by their class teacher. If possible, please can they now arrive at school at a slightly earlier time of 8.45am, so that the children will be in school ready for registration at 8.50am.

At the end of the day, all children will leave school at 3.15pm as normal. However, if you have a child in Class Bray who have siblings in other classes, they may be collected from Class Bray at 3.10pm, to enable parents to go to the main playground to meet their child/children.

Although we are trying to get back to things as normal as possible, we kindly request that parents still socially distance and to wear a mask should they wish to do so.
