We have not been able to go on this beach trip for the last 2 years due to COVID so children and staff are really looking forward to this fantastic day. We will send out a letter with more details shortly but we wanted to be able to share the good news with you asap. We aim to go on Wednesday July 13th. Our wonderful PTA have offered to help subsidise the trip and pay half the costs of the coaches. Therefore, we are pleased to say the trip will work out at £3.50 per child, with an ice cream included in the cost. This will be on Parentpay shortly and we will notify you when it will be live. We are looking forward to a day of digging sand castles, sunshine, games and fun.

• QUEEN'S JUBILEE CELEBRATIONS - THURSDAY 26th MAY

We are holding a celebration on Thursday May 26th for the Queen's Jubilee. On this day, children may dress-up as a King or Queen or dress in red, white and blue or dress in anything to do with the Royal Family.

During the morning, the children will enjoy activities within their classes.

At lunchtime, to celebrate we will be serving a special menu of Jubilee fish and chips and a Union Jack cupcake. We will also be serving the vegetarian option, Quorn nuggets. There will be no jacket potato option on this day.

In the afternoon from 2.30pm, parents are invited to join us on the top playground. EACH CLASS will form a love timeline of the key events that happened during the Queen's reign. We will finish with the whole school singing the National Anthem.

The PTA are very kindly going to organise some refreshments at the end of the day for us all to enjoy.

The children have also asked if we could have a crown making competition for each class. Therefore, we ask children and parents if they would like to make a crown at home using any materials and medium they would like. If a family would like their child to do this in school instead, please let us know. The crowns are to be brought into school on Thursday May 26th and will be judged during the celebrations.

For the Jubilee celebrations we would like to decorate the school and thought some of you might be able to help by lending us any Union Flags you may have or any red, white and blue bunting. If you are able to help these items can be dropped into the school office.

School News

The Devon Virtual Games Events hosted by Active Devon and the Devon School Games are holding a new competition this term.

The Birmingham 2022 Commonwealth Games will bring people together, so schools across Devon will try and 'skip to the games' and work together as a team. This skipping challenge is encouraging mass participation in schools and all year groups are taking part in school.

To ensure everyone "virtually" starts from the same location in Devon, Devon Virtual Games have done a little research to find the central point in Devon and this is Crediton. The distance between Crediton and the games is 170 miles which is equivalent to 340,000 steps. One skip equals one step and there are approximately 2,000 steps in a mile. We are going to all try and skip as much as possible to see if we can reach (or beat) 340,000 skips!

All children will have access to skipping ropes in school and can record their skips on paper with their name on it. This paper can be handed in to the box outside Class Taw (Miss Shapland's class) and the older year groups will start adding together everyone's totals each week. Children are also very welcome to record their skips at home and bring in their totals from this too.

We are excited to work as a team to complete this challenge.
