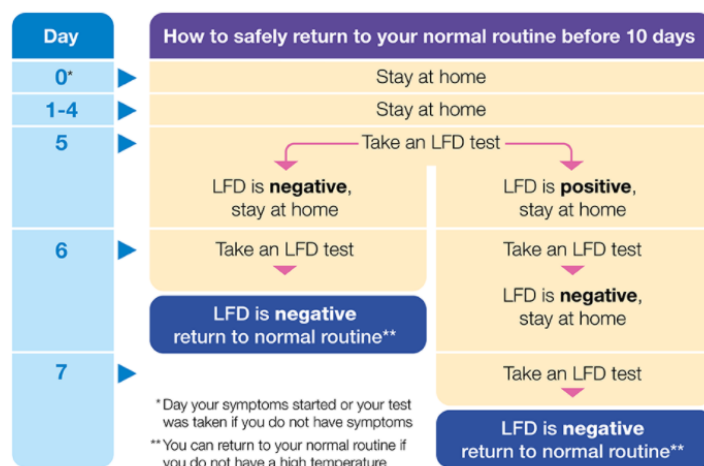

Sadly, we would like to make you aware that yet again we are having cases of Covid reported in school by both staff and pupils. Please follow the guidance below.

It appears that one of the main symptoms of Omicron is sickness and diarrhoea.

- You would only do a LFT if you or your child have symptoms
- If you feel ill and have Covid symptoms, at the moment, you can still go and get a PCR test.
- If a child has symptoms and or is positive they **must not attend school**.
- If they are positive they are to follow this grid below.
- (If your day 5 LFD test result is positive, you can continue taking LFD tests until you receive 2 consecutive negative test results).

How to safely return to your normal routine before 10 days



We would like to remind parents to inform us of any change to your child's normal pick up arrangements. Sometimes we are told by children who they are going home with and we have not always been notified by their parents.

School News

This week we have found a number of children wearing smart watches to school. Smart watches are camera, video and voice recorder enabled and therefore pose the same concerns as mobile phones in terms of safeguarding. We have a number of children within the school that are not allowed their images to be used as this could cause a safeguarding threat to them. We request that no child brings in any sort of device that can record images or videos of others. Students are allowed to wear analogue watches only.
