# A Message from Mrs Denham Severe weather conditions and the closure of School

I thought I would take the opportunity to update you on the procedures for the closure of the school in bad weather.

- 1. We will send out a message on Bratton Fleming CP School Facebook page as soon as we know the weather conditions, we will also put a message on the Bratton Fleming PTA Facebook page.
- 2. You can register with Devon County Council school closures, alert me -stay up to date. The email link is: <a href="https://new.devon.gov.uk/schools/closure/">https://new.devon.gov.uk/schools/closure/</a>
  They will then alert you if the school is closed.
- 3. Listen to Heart Radio.
- 4. If you are unsure, as a last resort please telephone either Bratton Fleming school on 01598710337. However, if we cannot get into school to man the phone please try Holywell School on 01271 345908, they may be open to assist you. We will always have staff, if possible, to answer the telephone.

We will always try, wherever possible, to remain open. Alternatively, it may be safer to open school later than normal.

Individual families should assess the risk posed by their journey to school and make their own decision. Many families who live close to the school will have a different level of risk to those who have much more complex travel arrangements. Let's hope that we have a trouble-free winter!
