#### Museum and Library Visit

Yesterday, classes Lyn, Taw and Torridge had a wonderful visit to Barnstaple Museum and Library. They took part in an Evacuation workshop learning all about the children who were evacuated from cities to Bideford on the train. We heard stories about evacuees that lived in Clovelly, Westward Ho! and Ilfracombe. We also wrote our own Evacuee label which would have been tied onto our coats and learnt about what parents needed to pack for boys and girls. For our last task, we were given World War 2 artefacts to handle and we had to try and work out what they were used for. Next, we had a tour around the museum looking at all the wonderful displays from different periods in time. The children thoroughly enjoyed these exhibits and it is well worth another visit if you get the chance! Finally, we walked to the library to learn about the Dewey system for non-fiction books and how fiction books are located by the writer's surname. All the children were given a leaflet about the wonderful activities and events that happen there, many of which are free of charge. All the adults thought the behaviour and attitude of the children was excellent. Many thanks for collecting your child/children at the end of the day.
